miles from Manchester city centre.



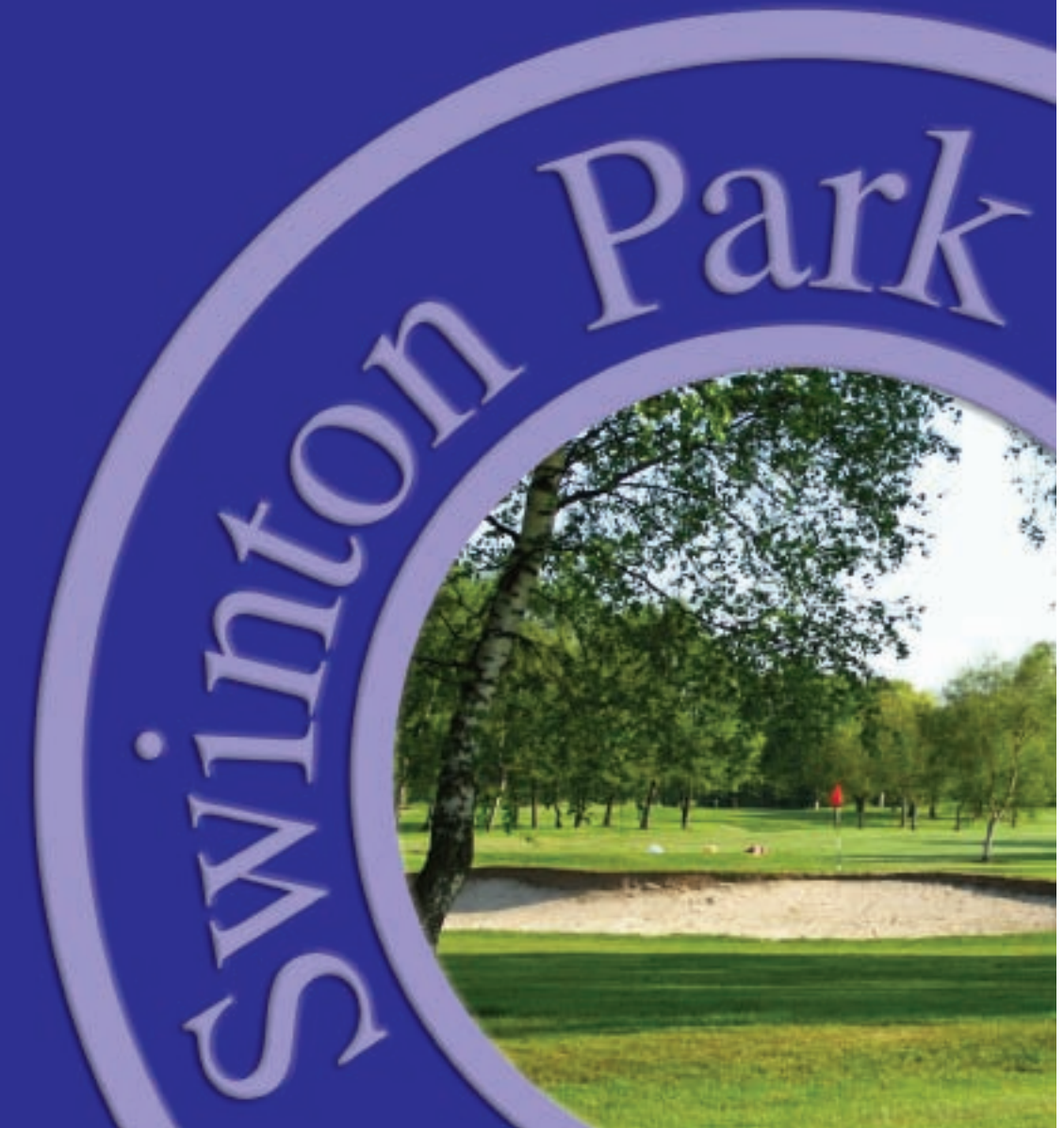

## Terms and conditions for visiting parties

**Please ensure that all members of your party are aware of these conditions**

Swinton Park is not a course for beginners. It is expected that all your players can play to a reasonable standard and will not hold up play. A handicap certificate may be required. Each player must have a set of clubs, proper footwear and is expected to know and comply with the normal etiquette of golf.

**Dress:** Jeans, t-shirts, shell suits and other unsuitable attire are not allowed on the course or in the clubhouse. On the course, shots must be tailored with hems no more than 2 inches above the knee and socks must be knee length or white sports socks. Shirts must be tucked into waistband and caps must not be reversed. The General Manager and Professional are empowered to require players to change into suitable clothing or leave the course.

**Fees and deposits:** Green fees per day are £25 for weekdays inclusive of VAT. Visiting parties must pay a deposit of £10 per person when returning the booking form otherwise the booking may not be accepted. If the number of players is less than the number booked, the club WILL retain the deposits of those not attending. Green fees and catering charges (if applicable) are to be paid on the day of play with cheques made payable to Swinton Park Golf Club Limited. Except by prior arrangement all drinks should be purchased with cash.

**Confirmation:** The organiser should confirm precise numbers, at least three days before the event. **This is the minimum number that the visiting party will be charged for.** The club cannot guarantee to accommodate more players than originally booked.

**Cancellation:** Deposits will not be refunded in the event of the party cancelling their visit within the ten week period before the visit takes place. If the party cancels their visit within three days of the date of the visit, they **WILL** be liable for any charges that have been incurred by the caterers. If the course is closed due to inclement weather, the deposit will be returned in full but the club will not accept any further liability to the party.

The club reserves the right at its absolute discretion to cancel the booking and refund the deposit in whole or part if the booking is potentially detrimental to the reputation of the club.

**Advertising signs:** No posters, signs or displays may be erected, fixed to walls, trees or fences, anywhere on the premises of the club without prior authority from the General Manager.

**Mobile phones:** These are a nuisance to other players and visitors are requested to switch these off. The use of mobile phones in the clubhouse is not encouraged and messages for visitors can be left with the bar staff. Outgoing calls can be made from the payphone situated near the function suite entrance.

**Insurance:** Organisers are advised to have appropriate insurance and should note that Swinton Park Golf Club bears no responsibility for loss of equipment, clothing, or valuables. Any damage or accident caused by the playing of golf must be reported to the Duty Manager on completion of play.

**Function suite:** If using the Claremont Suite, visitors are expected to remain within the confines of this suite. Any form of entertainment must be specified on the booking form and be approved by either the House Manager or General Manager.
